- **Library cards are non-transferable.**
- Limit of 30 total items checked out per library card, plus eBooks and eAudiobooks.
- New card holders are limited to 5 items for the first checkout.
- Lost library cards must be reported immediately.

Renew materials, when allowed, for the time period of the original loan and up to a maximum of three renewals:

- online at www.slcolibrary.org and click on "View my Library Record."
- bring materials to any County Library.
- call Customer Service at 801-943-4636.

One renewal on eAudiobooks.**

Fees for lost or damaged items:

- \$5.00 if the items are returned with damage that can be repaired;
- \$5.00 processing fee on items returned with one or more missing parts, plus the cost of replacing missing parts;
- \$5.00 processing fee plus the cost of the replacement for materials lost or returned damaged beyond repair.

Charges of \$3.00 or more may be paid by credit card.

How to get a library card

Library cards are free to Salt Lake County residents who are at least 18 years old and present proof of identification and residency, such as a **Utah Driver's License** or **Utah ID card** or **Driving Privilege card with current address listed**

OR

- Current government-issued picture ID such as a passport, permanent resident card, or the Matricula Consular

PLUS ONE of the following:

- Current lease agreement
- Current utility or cell phone bill
- Current mortgage papers or property tax notice
- Current pay check stub
- Current government-issued correspondence
- Current hospital/doctor bill or medical enrollment

An adult resident may sign for a library card for a minor child. The adult must accompany the minor, prove residency and agree to pay any charges accrued.
