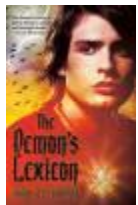

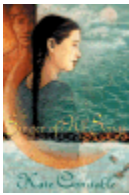
### The Warrior Heir

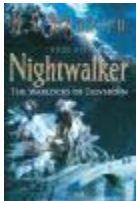

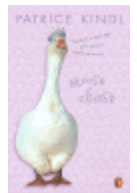

Anita is transported from London to the realm of Faerie where she discovers that she is the daughter of King Oberon and Queen Titania.



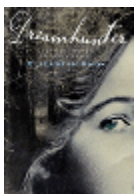

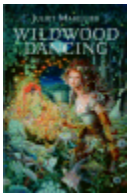
## A Wizard of Earthsea

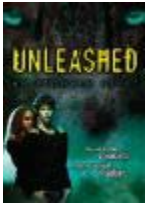
